



## Private Pilot Outline

### I. Intro to Maneuvers Apx. 7 Flights

During this beginning phase the student will be introduced to the maneuvers listed. To pass this phase the student should have a basic understanding of the maneuvers and be able to perform them with no serious problems.

1. Straight and Level, Climbs, Turns, and Decent
2. Slow Flight Pg 24
3. Power off Stall Pg 25
4. Power on Stall Pg 26
5. Emergency Procedures
6. S-Turns, Turns Around a Point Pg 20, 21
7. Steep Bank Turns Pg 31
8. Basic Instrument Flying

#### *Pre-Solo Ground School*

### II. Take-Off and Landings Apx. 3 Flights Pg 8, 38, 42

During this Phase the student will stay in the traffic pattern and work solely on perfecting take-offs and landings. To complete this stage the student must show strong control of the airplane and good decision making. The completion will be the student's FIRST SOLO. After that the next flight will be one more day in the pattern and more solo.

### III. Maneuvers Review and Preparation for Solo Flight from the Pattern

Apx. 4 Flights I Night Flight

During this phase the student returns to the practice area and reviews the maneuvers previously learned. The student will be aware of the standards to pass the final check ride. During these reviews the students will also make sure they can maneuver to and from the practice area for solo flight. Performance take-off and landings and VOR Navigation will also be introduced.

IV. **Solo Maneuvers to the Practice Area** 3 Flights

During these flights the student will fly solo to the practice area to practice the maneuvers. The student will prepare for the first check flight over the maneuvers.

V. **Check Flight**

To continue on the student must pass this flight. To pass this flight the student will perform the maneuvers learned to check ride passing standards.

VI. **Cross Countries** 2 Dual Flights 3 Solo Flights

During this phase the student will learn how to navigate to different airports. After the initial ground school the student will fly to two different airports with the instructor. If the student shows competence in navigating they will go on 3 solo cross countries.

VII. **Final Finish-UP** Apx. 5 Flights Apx. 2 Solo Flights 1 Night Flight

During these final flights the student and instructor will practice the required maneuvers till the student can perform them successfully to pass the check ride.

***Oral Briefing***

VIII. **Final Check Flight**

This flight will be a mock check ride. The student will have to pass all required maneuvers to check ride standards. If the student fails some portion of the flight the instructor will decide what and how much training is further required.
